
Enjoy hot cocoa, Christmas cookies, and singing around a cozy fire, while watching the story of the first Christmas come alive.

ADVENT IS ALMOST HERE, 2023

As shocking as that may sound, Advent begins this Sunday, December 3rd. With the arrival of Advent, it is time to start thinking about Christmas and Christmas flowers.

Flowers to decorate our beautiful church for Christmas are given each year by parishioners as a way to honor or remember a person or event. The cost varies according to the particular plant, but averages about \$25. Any donation is just fine. There are designation forms available in front of the office, one will be included with this Sunday's worship booklet, and one will be mailed to you also.

Christmas flowers will remain in the church for Christmas and for the Sunday after, December 31, 2023. You are encouraged to take home a plant on that day after the 10 o'clock service.

In addition to Christmas flowers, we are looking for volunteers to help with the Greening of the Church which will take place after the 10 o'clock service on December 17th. Volunteers, both men and women, will decorate our indoor wreaths and hang them on the windows of the nave. We will also hang the outdoor wreaths, put electric candles in the windows and hang the big swag above the altar. We will also appreciate your help on December 31st when the wreaths and decorations will be taken down and stored away.

Are you 72 or older? Have you lost the ability to fully deduct charitable contributions because you no longer itemize federal income tax deductions? Do you make donations to St. Martha's regularly? If you answered yes to these questions, you may want to consider making a Qualified Charitable Distribution (QCD). A QCD is generally a non-taxable distribution made directly by the trustee of your IRA to St. Martha's or other qualified charities. A QCD reduces your Adjusted Gross Income (AGI) and thereby reduces taxes. If you are receiving a Required Minimum Distribution (RMD) from your IRA, a QCD can be used to satisfy the RMD. Please consult your tax advisor or tax return preparer to determine if a QCD could benefit you.
